You must pay using National Electronic Fund Transfer (NEFT) so that your payment is identified with an Unique Transaction Reference (UTR) number.

1. NEFT could be done from NEFT-enabled branch of any bank having unique IFSC code.
2. Please note that payment must be made in favour of "Indian Institute of Science Education and Research Kolkata" to **Indian Overseas Bank, Salt Lake City Branch, Kolkata**, A/C No. 089301000013928 (Name of the account: IISER-KOLKATA a/c Admission/Registration, IFSC Code: IOBA0000893, MICR: 700020029, Swift: IOBAINBB015, Branch code: 893) from any NEFT-enabled scheduled bank in India.
3. On making the payment, the receiving bank will provide you with the transaction details which will indicate the UTR number (usually 16 alphanumeric characters) along with the name of the depositor.
4. NEFT protocol for all banks provides an Additional Information section where you must specify (i) registrant's name, (ii) the phrase "Registration fee".
5. You **must fill the online registration form** (where you have to enter the UTR number) within July 25, 2012. Please bring the **signed** copy of the **registration slip** (generated through online registration) which needs to be deposited at the time of registration. **Submission of the signed copy of registration slip along with the undertaking forms completes your registration process on the aforementioned date.**

Other means of payment, such as, by cash or Demand Draft will NOT be accepted.

It is reiterated that whoever fails to register on the date mentioned will be debarred from all kinds of academic activities for the current semester. Post-facto request at any pretext may not be entertained.
