1.	Duration:	Engagement in the above posts will initially be for 11(eleven) months, which may be renewed based on the candidate's performance, on the same consolidated salary.

Job Descriptions:	(a) Provide confidential one-on-one counselling sessions to students facing stress, anxiety, depression, relationship issues, academic pressure, homesickness, and other emotional challenges (b) Counsel students to cope with examination stress, burnout, and related issues (c) Organize regular mental health awareness programmes, stress management workshops, peer-support sessions, and mindfulness training, in consultation with the Authorities (d) Respond to emergency mental health situations, including suicidal ideation, self-harm, or trauma, even beyond normal duty hours, as required (e) Maintain confidential case records, session summaries, and student progress documentation in accordance with professional and institutional standards. (f) Coordinate with faculty members, wardens, Deans, medical officers, and other clinical psychologists for integrated student care, while strictly respecting privacy and confidentiality (g) Serve as a member or advisor to institutional committees such as the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC), Students’ Wellness Committee, etc., as and when required (h) Perform any other duties and responsibilities as assigned by the Competent Authority of the Institute.
